So you want to write a book or edit collection of work ... let's talk about collaboration, mentoring, and the contribution you can make

Writing is one of the joys that comes with working in higher education. We are able to contribute to knowledge, new insights and capacity building in self and peers. As we build a research and publication trajectory, writing a book and editing a book or journal special issue are types of outputs to consider. What comes with working in one or more of these formats is an opportunity that extends just beyond the dissemination of new knowledge.

There is a lot of advice from publishers available on how to approach proposals. But, we often do not hear from those who strategically engage with these outputs with consideration to the bigger picture - mentoring, collaboration, and all the other opportunities that exist.

In this workshop we go through a coaching conversation about the why for you, exploring your curiosity and building your awareness about the what, how, why, and when. A/Professor Narelle Lemon will draw on her experience as a book author, book editor, book series editor, and special issue journal editor.
